### **FORUM ON CHICANA/LATINA HUMAN RIGHTS – Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup> (5 p.m. – 7 p.m.)**

The Forum on Chicana/Latina Human Rights issues will examine the human condition of Latina women in the United States and in Latin America. The session will specifically focus on the situation occurring in Ciudad Juarez and Guatemala and address the atrocities and heinous crimes experienced by hundreds of women and girls. It will draw attention to the status on reproductive rights and healthcare; as well as give emphasis to the recent pro-choice reform granting Mexican women the right to have a legal abortion. The forum will also highlight the sanctuary movement in the United States and address efforts by the church to provide protective refuge to undocumented immigrants – many of them women – who are forced to separate from their spouse and/or children because of deportation orders.

The session will be led by a panel of Chicana/Latina experts, who have utilized their leadership roles; educational expertise and political activism to draw attention to these critical issues, which have altered and continuously transform the lives of Latinas across the continent.
